

Extra Territoriality Conduct Outside of School

5.9

Rationale

1. The Waiuku College Board of Trustees recognises the need to provide a safe environment for staff and students both within and beyond the school grounds. Actions of students that are outside the school grounds can create health and safety issues for fellow students and for staff. For this reason, the Board of Waiuku College reserve the right to take disciplinary action against students who behave in such an inappropriate manner outside the grounds of Waiuku College which causes health and safety issues for students or staff, or damages the reputation of the school.

Requirements

1. Inappropriate behaviour in the context of this policy is defined as any behaviour that would result in school disciplinary action should this behaviour have occurred on the school grounds during school hours.
2. This policy includes students travelling to and from school and to and from school activities.
3. This policy includes inappropriate behaviour by way of electronic device use that occurs outside Waiuku College but impacts on the health and safety of staff or students.
4. This policy applies to out of school behaviour that has a negative or detrimental impact on the reputation of the school.
