## **SPORT DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE:**

Waiuku College implements. Disciplinary Procedure if:

- (a) Any player involved in an incident of gross misconduct during a game of sport where he/she is representing Waiuku College
- (b) Any Player repeatedly failing to fulfill their "studentship" obligations at the College
- (c) If you have been stood down from Waiuku College, you are automatically stood down from that week of sport from your chosen team.

## Student Code of Expectations for all Sporting Games/Trips

If your child is representing the school in a school-organised event, the welfare and behaviour of all those involved comes under the jurisdiction of Waiuku College. This applies throughout the full duration of the trip - 24 hours a day.

You are attending this event as a representative of Waiuku College. Hence, your behaviour must reflect the fact that you are an ambassador of the school. You are expected to display the full values of the Waiuku Way.

This means you must:

- Cooperate with all instructions of supervising staff
- Obey the law
- Follow all safety procedures carefully
- Follow the Waiuku College Player's Fair Play Agreement.
- Follow the guidelines/rules/expectations of the sporting event
- Behave in a mature and appropriate manner
- Not be involved with any cigarettes, other drugs, or alcohol
- Treat others with respect
- Wear the correct uniform as advised by Mrs Coe or your coach.

#### FAIR PLAY AGREEMENT

- Always play by the rules.
- Let my coach or team captain handle disputes and respect the decisions of officials without gesture or argument.
- Treat opponents with respect. Win with Humility. Lose with Dignity.
- Show appreciation for good play by both my team-mates and my opponents.
- Always control my temper and exercise self-control.
- Always play hard and fairly.
- Remember that I am playing because I enjoy the sport and work at achieving my personal best.

I understand that if I do not give adequate warning about non-attendance at a team practice that I may be stood down for the following game.

If I continue not to attend practices without legitimate reason or fulfil the stated expectations, I accept that I may be dropped from the team and replaced by another player.
